Very Easy True Stories – A picture based high interest – low vocabulary book for Levels 1 & 2 students. There is a short, interesting story followed by pronunciation, spelling, vocabulary, comprehension and writing experiences. Answer key is in the back of the book.

All New Very Easy Stories – Same as *Very Easy True Stories* – a picture based first reader for Levels 1 & 2.

All New Easy True Stories – A picture based first reader. Same format as above except for Levels 2 & 3.

Easy True Stories – This is a picture based beginning reader.

More Easy Stories Plus- Reading and activities to improve language skills of late Level 1 and Level 2 students. Works on comprehension, vocabulary, and discussion topics.

Easy Stories Plus – Works on reading and language skills. Same as *More Easy Stories*.

True Stories in the News - For students in Levels 3, 4, and above. This book features an interesting news story followed by vocabulary, comprehension, grammar, discussion, and writing experiences.

More True Stories – A high beginning reader (Level 4 and up). Works on the same skills as *True Stories in the News*.

More Stories Plus – High interest, low vocabulary for late Level 2 and Level 3 students. Works on comprehension, vocabulary, discussion, and writing.

Beyond True Stories – A high intermediate reader (Level 4 & up). Works in developing reading skills, study skills, sharing ideas, and vocabulary.

Life Prints- Level 1 (low beginning), Level 2 (high beginning), Level 3 (low intermediate). Life Prints is fully reproducible. It is full of real life experiences that develop language skills and cultural understanding.

Foundations – Excellent for low beginning and beginning learners of English. This colorful book works on listening skills, vocabulary, grammar, and uses every day knowledge and information.

Survival English - Books 1 – 3 exposes students to every day situations and information. These books have some very good discussion topics. It contains a teacher's edition, but is not necessary.

Side by Side Plus – Life Skills and Standards Books 1,2,3.
Excellent source for every day conversation.

Conversations for Work- For beginning and intermediate students needing to develop and practice language skills for effectively communicating on the job.

English for Every Day Activities- Teaches step-by step activities of more than 60 daily activities. (Basic)

English for Work Activities- Gives the student the tools to communicate 50 work related activities. (level 3 and up).

Talk-A-Tivities- Develop conversational skills with problem solving activities for pairs (2 students or a tutor and student). Best for high beginner and intermediate.

Look Who's Talking- For group interaction activities.

Communication Spot Light- Speaking and listening strategies for improving communication skills. (high beginner and up).

A Phrasal Verb Affair – Few languages have phrased verbs, but English has thousands. In any conversation, we are using these phrases all the time. This would be best for level 3 and higher.

The Grab Bag of Telephone Activities – Many students have more trouble using the phone than in face to face conversation. The Grab Bag is an excellent source for telephone ideas. This book is reproducible and cannot be checked out. Please use the copier for pages you will use.

Phonics

Flipping Phonics - Fun way for students to practice decoding skills. Each phonics card is cut into three columns. Students flip cards to make words and make up nonsense words to be sounded out.

Think it Through – An entertaining learning kit that works with phonics, general information, health issues, comprehension, and more. Can be used for instruction or self-paced. The kit uses tiles to check correct responses. Please return this kit in 2 months or sooner.

Focus on Phonics - (Student and Teacher Editions). These books correlate with the Laubach Level and page your student is working on. They are for additional practice. The student does not have to do the entire book, but it provides extra practice in problem areas.

Say the Word- (Levels 3 and up). This approach helps students master letter patterns for sounding out words. There is a student handbook, teacher's manual, and photocopy masters.

Pronunciation Games-for all ability levels.

Easing into Essays- (for pre GED and higher)
